This takes the total raised in the first ten years of the Big Curry Lunch to £1.7m - a huge result for the City and the Charity. This feat would not have been possible without the generosity of the Livery Companies and Ward Clubs and the support of so many sponsors, both corporate and individual, whose support forms the backbone of the Lunch. 
